High-quality images taken on phones or cameras are both welcome, as long as the entrant is the original owner of the photo. Submissions must be uploaded via the official English Riviera webpage here.

- Deadline for entries: 30 September 2025 (23:59 GMT)
- Shortlist announced: Week commencing 06 October 2025
- Winner announced: Week commencing 13 October 2025

A panel of judges, including representatives from the English Riviera BID Company, the local community, and the creative industries, will select five shortlisted entries. The public will then be invited to vote for the overall winner via social media polls on the English Riviera BID Company's channels.

The winning photographer will:

- Feature in regional marketing campaigns (print, web, and social media)
